
First Destination Post-Graduation Outcomes by College:

The information below shows the post




The table below shows gross starting salaries of full-time, non-temporary employed graduates by college. Respondents in the College of Professional Studies are excluded due to a small number of respondents. The salary numbers exclude those active in the military, those in a post-graduation stipend-paid service position, those in a temporary position, and those employed as Medical Scribes. About 68 percent of full-time employed respondents reported salary information on the survey (compared with 69% in 2016-2017 and 67% in 2015-16).



Graduate and Professional Education

Those pursuing graduate/professional school were asked to indicate the type of degree they are pursuing and the field of study of the degree. The survey also collected the name of the school, although that information is not included within this report.
