

Readmission and Academic Censure/Satisfactory Academic Progress Appeal: Undergraduate

Purpose: used by former students to appeal academic dismissal from a college or the university and/or failure to maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress for financial aid eligibility the last term of attendance and also wish to seek readmission to the university as an undergraduate.

Student Instructions

- 1. Complete Sections 1-4 of this form using a computer.
- a. a handwritten form will not be accepted.
- b. an incomplete form without the required documents attached will not be processed and returned to you for completion.
- 2. Print the form using the 'Print Form' button.
- 3. Type answers to the questions in Section 5 in a separate document.
- 4. Sign the form in Section 6; a digital signature is <u>not</u> acceptable.
- 5. Submit the signed appeal form, the document in Section 5 and any supporting documentation by the deadline for readmission, as per the Academic Calendar via one of the methods listed at the bottom of page 2 of this form.

6. All appeals and supporting documents must be received by the deadline. No exceptions will be made to the deadline.

- Notes:
- a. if you have a Bursar or Student Affairs hold that will prevent you from being readmitted, clear these with the appropriate office.
- b. transcripts are not accepted if delivered by the student; they must be received via mail directly from the high school or postsecondary institution's record office.
- c. the request will be reviewed by the Academic Censure Committee and colleges in rank order indicated below.
- d. this is a request for readmission and is not a guarantee of acceptance, or a guarantee of being admitted to your requested major, if readmitted.


