Responsible and Ethical Conduct of Research for Undergraduate and Graduate Students

Undergraduate and graduate students both enroll in GRAD 9953 Responsible Conduct of Research. This is a

in-person discussions. The course is organized into three units, each containing selected CITI modules (the "RCR Refreshers" series) and discussion meetings. Participants access instructional materials for the course and information about the face-to-face discussions via an associated D2L. Participants are required to successfully pass the quizzes associated with each CITI module (at 80%) and attend all three face-to-face discussions.
