An important component of training in becoming a future independent investigator will involve formal, continued instruction in the responsible and ethical conduct of research. In accordance with the America COMPETES II announcement number NOT-OD-10-019 and NOT-OD-22-055, Marquette University has developed a detailed plan to provide appropriate training and oversight in the responsible and ethical conduct of research.
